### 7.1.1 Institution has initiated Gender audit and measure for the promotion of gender equity.

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## 1. AUDIT REPORT

A gender audit is the process of assessing policies, programs, and procedures in an organization to identify gender biases and determine how equally women and men are treated and represented.

Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) at our institution conducted a gender audit to assess gender equality and inclusivity on campus. The audit examined policies, practices, and facilities from a gender perspective. It looked at aspects such as admissions, curriculum, recruitment, organizational culture, safety and security, facilities, and support systems through a gender lens. The aim was to identify gaps in order to recommend measures to promote gender justice and create an enabling environment for all genders. The IQAC will follow up by working with various stakeholders to implement the recommendations over a period, thereby enhancing gender equity and accountability on campus. Regular gender audits by the IQAC will help assess progress and drive positive change.

## Gender balance within the Institution

Gender balance refers to maintaining an equitable proportion of male and female representation within the institution, both among the student body in various programs and within the staff structure. The underlying principle is rooted in the acknowledgment that, historically, women have faced limited access to resources and opportunities due to societal structures acting as barriers. This disparity leads to reduced capabilities among women, creating a cascading impact on their empowerment and access to developmental initiatives.

In the year 2019-20, out of 129 total teaching staff 105 (81.39\%) were males and 105 (18.60\%) were females. The trend analysis reveals a consistent growth in the number of female students, with a notable surge of $19.84 \%$ observed during the academic year 2022-2023

Students: The pie chart shows the gender breakdown of students at the university and the increase in enrolment in 2019-2020. Of the 2,311 total students, 789 ( $34.14 \%$ ) were female while (65.85\%) were male. The proportion of female students increased notably from $14.36 \%$ to $34.14 \%$ between the two academic years.

Faculty: The pie chart illustrates the gender statistics of the 129-teaching staff at the university and the growth in faculty numbers in 2019-2020. 105 ( $81.3 \%$ ) were male and 24 ( $18.6 \%$ ) were female. The percentage of female faculty raise slightly from $16.4 \%$ to $18.6 \%$ compared to last year.

Non-teaching: The pie chart presents the gender data of the 184 non-teaching staff. In 20192020, 122 ( $66.30 \%$ ) were male and $62(33.69 \%)$ were female. There was a moderate increase in the percentage of female non-teaching staff from $27.61 \%$ to $33.69 \%$.

From 2018-2019 to 2019-2020 academic years, we can observe the percentage of females increased a bit in all groups - students, faculty, and non-teaching staff. The biggest increase was in female students.

Students: The First pie chart in figure 3 shows the percentage of male and female students at the university in 2020-2021. Out of 3349 total students, 2198 or $65.63 \%$ were male. 1151 or $34.36 \%$ were female. The percentage of female students remained stable at around $34 \%$ in both years.

Faculty: The Second pie chart shows the number of male and female faculty at the university in 2020-2021. Out of 155 teachers, 126 or $81.3 \%$ were male. 29 or $18.7 \%$ were female. The percentage of female faculty increased slightly from $18.6 \%$ to $18.7 \%$ compared to the last year.

Non-teaching staff: The third pie chart in the above figure indicates gender-wise information of total non-teaching faculty in the university. In the year 2020-2021, out of 207 staff, 143
$(69.1 \%)$ were males and 64 ( $30.9 \%$ ) were females. There was a small decrease in the percentage of female non-teaching staff from $33.69 \%$ to $30.9 \%$

Non-Teaching staff: The third pie chart shows the percentage of male and female nonteaching staff in 2021-2022. Out of 288 staff, 194(67.3\%) were male and 94(32.63\%) were female.

Between 2020-2021 and 2021-2022, the gender balance stayed quite steady among students. However, there was a slight decrease in the proportion of female faculty and a small increase
in the percentage of female non-teaching staff. In 2021-2022, males still outnumbered females considerably in all categories.

Faculty: The second pie chart shows the percentage of male and female faculty at the university in 2022-2023. Out of 262 faculty, 210 or $80.15 \%$ were male and 52 or $19.84 \%$ were female.

Non-Teaching Staff: The third pie chart shows the percentage of male and female nonteaching staff in 2022-2023. Out of 359 staff, 232 ( $64.62 \%$ ) were male and 127 or $35.37 \%$ were female.

## Summary \& conclusion

Over the 5 academic years, it was observed that there is a growth in the percentage of females increased in all groups - students, faculty, and non-teaching staff. Though there is little drop of in few years in between but we can observe growth in the last 5 years. Whereas we can see major growth in the proportion of female students.

- We are including the Gender equity to be part of all university policies and programs wherever it is applicable.
- So far, no issues were registered about gender bias by any staff till date.
- Management and staff actively support gender equality and sensitivity be means of various activities.
- University has few strengths and opportunities for better gender balance.
- Weaknesses can be improved through gradual value changes.
- Though significant improvement in Female students' enrolment, and we haven't registered any gender-related complaints. Positive impact can be achieved through strong will and actions.
